 - 5) Dual Admission applicants for full-time day programs are eligible for the Dual Admission Achievement Scholarship.

- 1) Applicants must submit high school transcripts or GED results.
 - 2) Applicants must submit two letters of recommendation (one of which must be academic in nature).
 - 3) Applicants must submit an essay or personal statement.
 - 4) SAT or ACT scores - if taken within the past three years, score received must total a 1000 combined (critical reading and math only with a minimum 450 received on both portions) or a composite score of 1080 on the new SAT. If SAT or ACT scores are not available or do not qualify, students will be required to take the NLN pre-RN entrance exam or the ATI-TEAS exam. Expected scores for the NLN exam should be within the average range for the overall score and at the 50th percentile or higher for the individual sections. ATI-TEAS scores must be in the proficient range or higher. Students must submit test scores at the time of application.
 - 5) Students must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 as well as a science GPA of 3.0 or better. Science GPA includes Anatomy and Physiology I and II
