- 2) Dual Admission applications must be completed on La Salle University's website, www.lasaApplidations are free.
- 3) Additional courses beyond the associategree can be taken at CCP to meet program requirements at La Salle.
- 4) CCP transcripts must be submitted at the time of admission review.
- 5) Final official transcripts must be sent as soon as the final semester is completed and associate's degree conferred
- 6) Students must uphold a grade point average of 2.5 or higher to qualify for Dual Admission.
- 7) Dual Admission applicasitor full-time day programs will be eligie for the Dual Admission Achievement Scholarship.

Additional Notesfor all applicants (Dual Admission and regular transfer)

- 1) The maximum manount of transfer credits awarded cannot exceed .70
- At least half of the courses required by the major department (i.e., major requirements) must be completed at La Salle
- 3) For admission review, official transcripts must be sent from all previous collation
- 4) All full-time day applicants will be eligible for the meritbased Founder's Scholarship. The award amount will depend on grade point average and quality of curriculum.
