Additional Notes for Dual Admission Applicants

- 1) Dual Admission Intent to Enroll forms must be completed on CCP's student portal before 45 college credits are earned.
- 2) Dual Admission applications must be completed on La Salle University's website, www.lasalle.edu. Applications are free.
- 3) Additional courses beyond the associate degree can be taken at CCP to meet program requirements at La Salle.
- 4) CCP transcripts must be submitted at the time of admission review.
- 5) Final official transcripts must be sent as soon as the final semester is completed and associate's degree conferred.
- 6) Students must uphold a grade point average of 2.5 or higher to qualify for Dual Admission.
- 7) Dual Admission applicants for full-time day programs will be eligible for the Dual Admission Achievement Scholarship.
- 8) Please note, in order to complete the B.S.W. in two years at La Salle, it is necessary to start in the fall term.

Additional Notes for all applicants (Dual Admission and regular transfer):

- 1) No more than one BHHS course will transfer to satisfy a Social Work major elective. A student can take one of the following BHHS courses to transfer as Social Work elective credit: BHHS 105, 106, 121, 131, 151, 161, 171, 194 or 212. If additional BHHS courses are taken, the credit transfer as general elective credit at best.
- 2) BHHS 103 Human Development and Behavior in the Social Environment satisfies SWK 280 Human Behavior in the Social Environment I.
- 3) The maximum amount of transferred credits awarded cannot exceed .70
- 4) At least half of the courses required by the major department (i.e., major requirements) must be completed at La Salle
- 5) For admission review, official transcripts must be sent from all previous colleges attended
- 6) All full-time day applicants will be eligible for the merit-based Founder's Scholarship. The award amount will depend on grade point average and quality of curriculum.
- 7) The Phi Theta Kappa Scholarship is offered to full-time day transfer applicants
