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**Additional Notes for Dual Admission Applicants:**

- 1) The Dual Admission Intent to Enroll form must be completed before 45 college credits are earned.
- 2) The Dual Admission application must be completed on La Salle University's website, [www.lasalle.edu](http://www.lasalle.edu). It is free to apply online.
- 3) DCCC transcript must be submitted at the time of admission review.
- 4) Final official transcripts must be sent by the student as soon as the final semester is completed and associate's degree conferred.
- 5) Dual Admission applicants for full-time day programs will be eligible for the Dual Admission Achievement Scholarship.

**Admission Requirements for ALL Full-Time Day BSN Applicants (Dual Admission and regular transfer):**

- 1) High school transcripts or GED results
- 2) Two letters of recommendation (one of which must be academic in nature)
- 3) Essay or personal statement
- 4) SAT or ACT scores - if taken within the past three years, score received must total 1080 on the SAT (critical reading and math only). If SAT or ACT scores are not available or do not qualify, students will be required to take the ATI-TEAS entrance exam. Students must meet the standardized benchmark on the TEAS exam. Students who will be taking the TEAS entrance exam will need to do so at the time of application.
- 5) Students must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 as well as a science GPA of 3.0 or better (science GPA includes Anatomy and Physiology I and II, Microbiology and Chemistry).
