Students interested in applying to LaSalle through the Dual Admission program must sign the Dual Admission Application before completing 45 college level credits. The Dual Admission Agreement includes a Core to Core component. Under the Dual Admission agreement, LaSalle University's Core will essentially be fulfilled by the Core at Manor College. In order to meet the requirements of LaSalle's Core, students must take one COREqualifier" at LaSalle, REL100: Religion Matters. This course must be taken at LaSalle because there is no equivalent course offered at the Manor.
